





Bar Post Assembly

- **1.1** Assemble the four corner posts with the floor frame using 6×6 lumbers and one door side post using 4×4 lumber according to the illustration below.
- **1.2** Secure the corner posts and door side post with #10 x 3" phillips flat head wood screws.



Bar Beam Assembly

- **2.1** Assemble the front, rear, left, right beam with half lap connection and the cross braces using 6 \times 6 lumbers according to the illustration below.
- **2.2** Secure the lumbers with #10 x 5" phillips flat head wood screws.



Bar Right Wall Frame Assembly

- **3.1** Assemble the right wall frame using 2 x 4 lumbers according to the illustration below.
- **3.2** Secure the lumbers with #10 x 3" phillips flat head wood screws.



Bar Rear Wall Sheathing Assembly

- **4.1** Assemble the rear wall sheathing using plywood siding plybead 11/32 according to the illustration below.
- **4.2** Secure the plywood with #10 x 1" phillips flat head wood screws.




Assemble The Roof Frame

5.1 Assemble the blocking board using 2×6 lumber and the fascias using 1×6 lumber according to the illustration below.

5.2 Secure blocking board and fascias with $#10 \times 3$ " and $#10 \times 2$ " phillips flat head wood screws.



Bar Roof Sheathing Assembly

- **6.1** You will need to prepare metal drip edge with 6" width. You will need 48' to cover it from all sides. Place the drip edge down, aligning it to the OSB edge. Use 2" nails to secure the first drip edge. When youplace the next drip edge piece, it should overlap the first by an inch.
- 6.2 You will need 110 square ft of building paper and asphalt shingle roofing.
- **6.3** Cover the OSB and drip edge with building paper. Try to install sheets with 1" overlapping. Use 2" nails to secure the sheets. Install asphalt shingle roofing using an industrial stapler.
