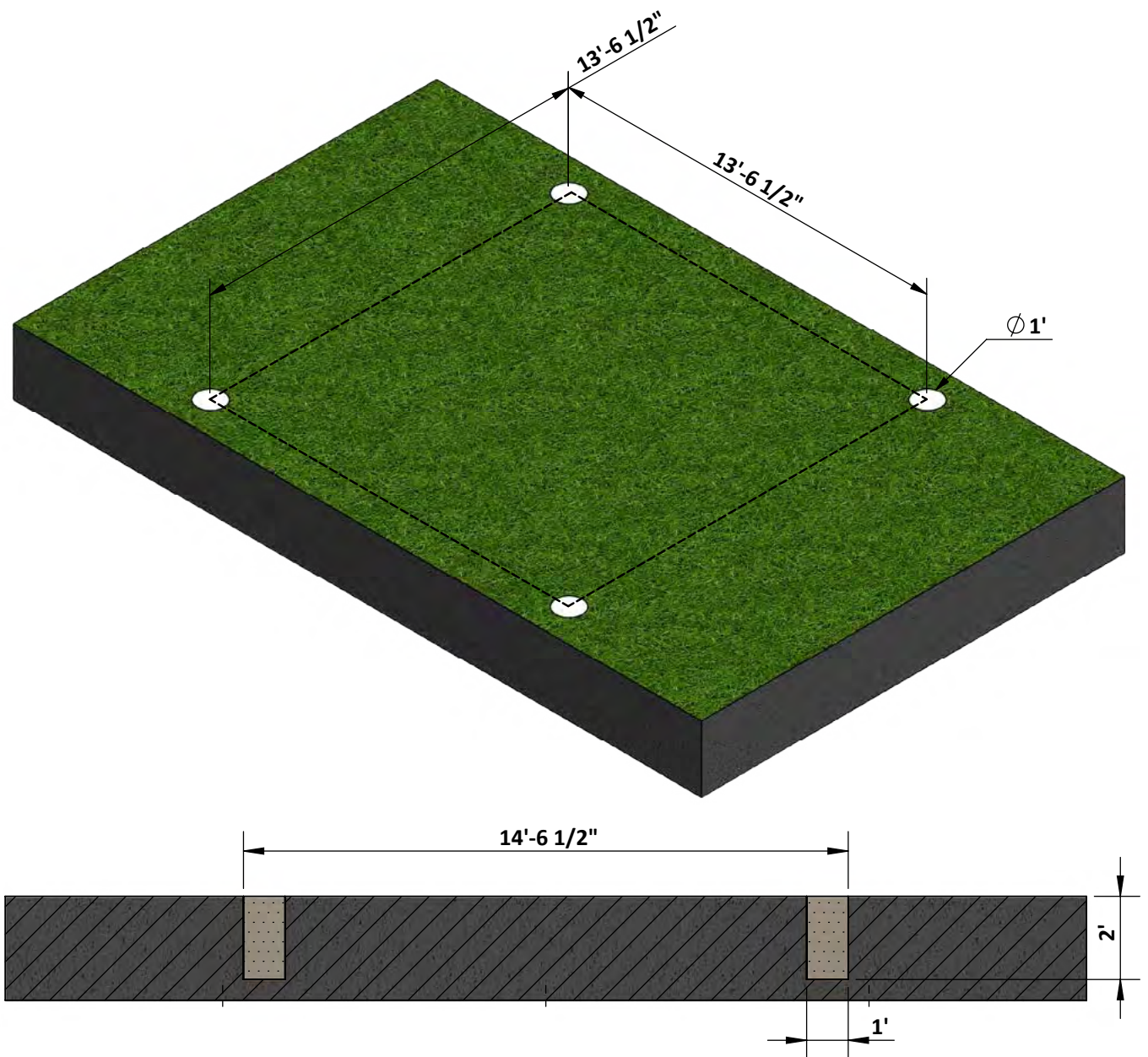
Model View



STEP 1

Foundation Preparation

1.1 Dig the hole of 2' depth and 1' diameter at each post location according to the dimensions on the drawing. pouring concrete into a tube form on the bottom, and set a metal post anchor bracket in the concrete



STEP 2

Post Installation

2.1 At this stage, two possible height options are presented: Standard height – 9 ft posts / 11.5 ft peak; Upgrade height – 10 ft posts / 13 ft peak for larger scale or vaulted ceiling effect.

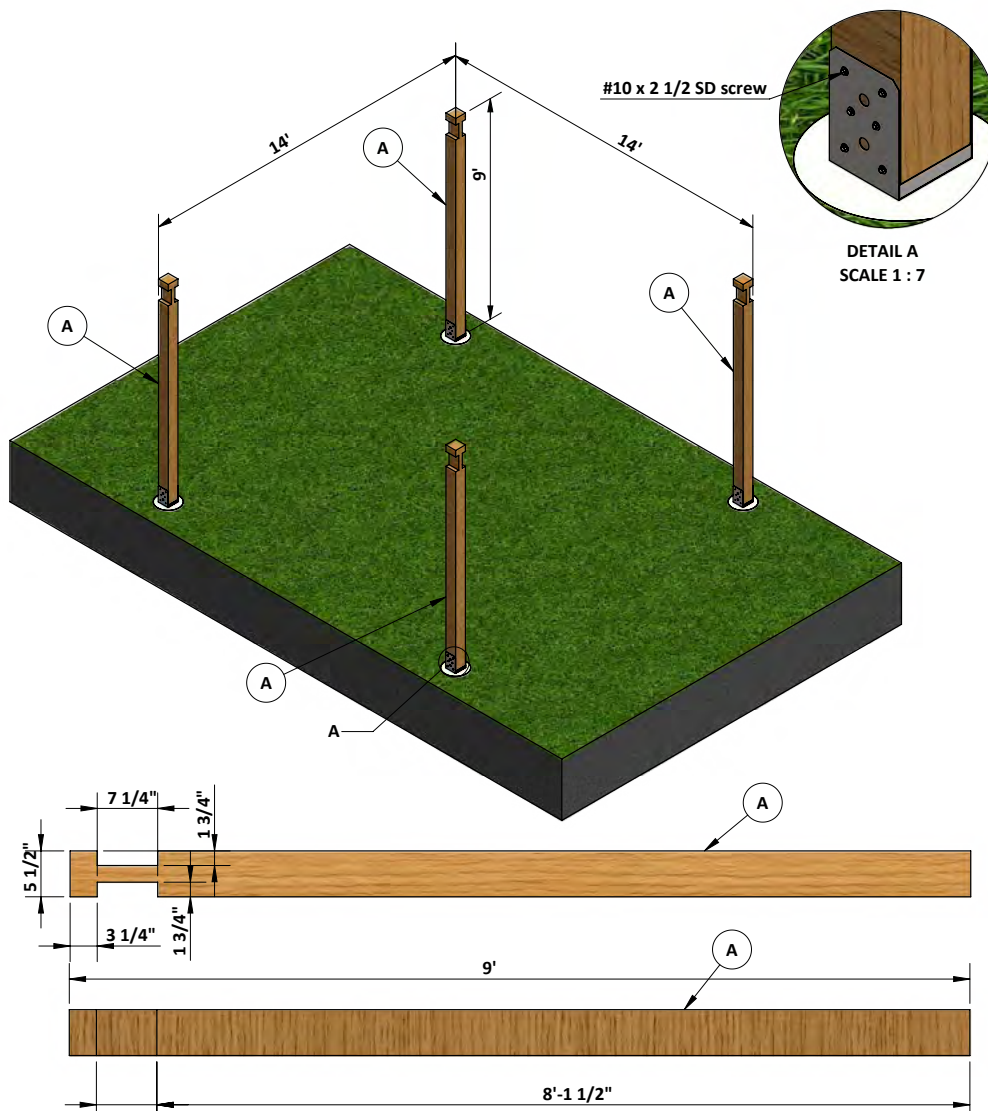
2.2 If you have high ceilings in a nearby house or want a vaulted feel / accommodate lighting/fan/hanging plants, choose the upgrade height. Check your local building code & HOA: some jurisdictions limit the height of accessory structures or require permits if they are above a certain height. For example, if the height is over 10-12 ft, this may result in extra regulation.

2.3 Using 6x6 lumber, prepare and install the posts. Provide cuttings for a half lap connection.

2.4 Secure the post to the base using SD Connector Screws #10 x 2½".

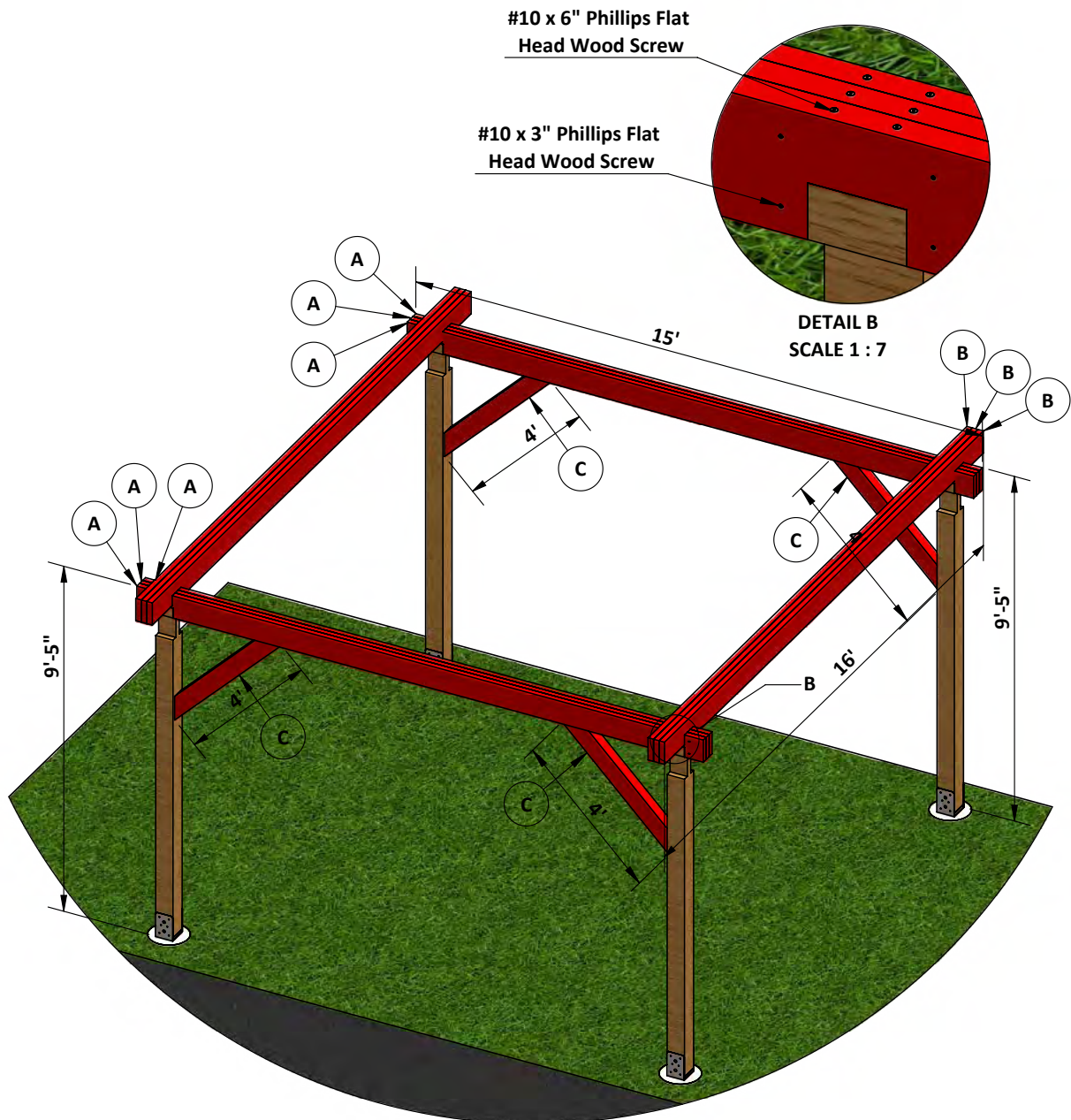
STEP 3

Headers and Cross braces assembly

3.1 Assemble the headers using 2 x 8 LVL and cross braces using 4 x 6 lumber.

3.2 Secure all Headers with post using #10 x 6" Phillips flat head wood screws and cross braces with #10 x 5" Phillips flat head wood screws.

A	Header	LVL (2 x 8)	15'	6
B	Header	LVL (2 x 8)	16'	6
C	Cross braces	Lumber (4x 6)	4'	4



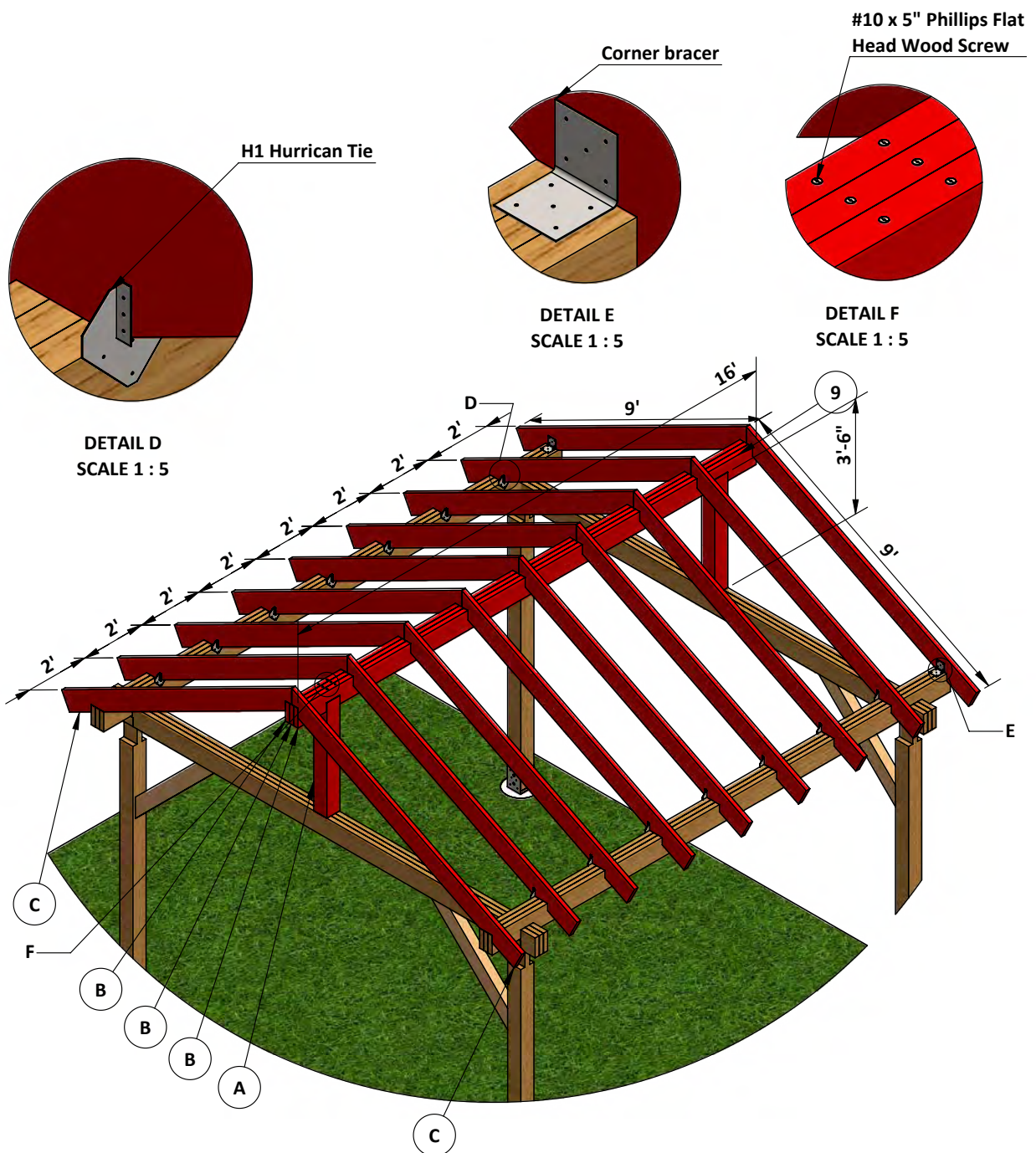
STEP 4

Roof Assembly

4.1 Assemble the rafters using 2 x 8 lumber, ridge board using 2 x 8 LVL and gable studs with 6 x 6 lumber.

4.2 Secure rafters with H16 hurricane tie and corner bracer with #10 x 1" Phillips flat head wood screws and roof beam with #10 x 6" Phillips flat head wood screws.

Pos	Description	Material	Dimension	Qty
A	Gable studs	Lumber (6 x 6)	3'-6"	2
B	Ridge board	LVL (2 x 8)	16'	3
C	Rafter	Lumber (2 x 8)	9'	18



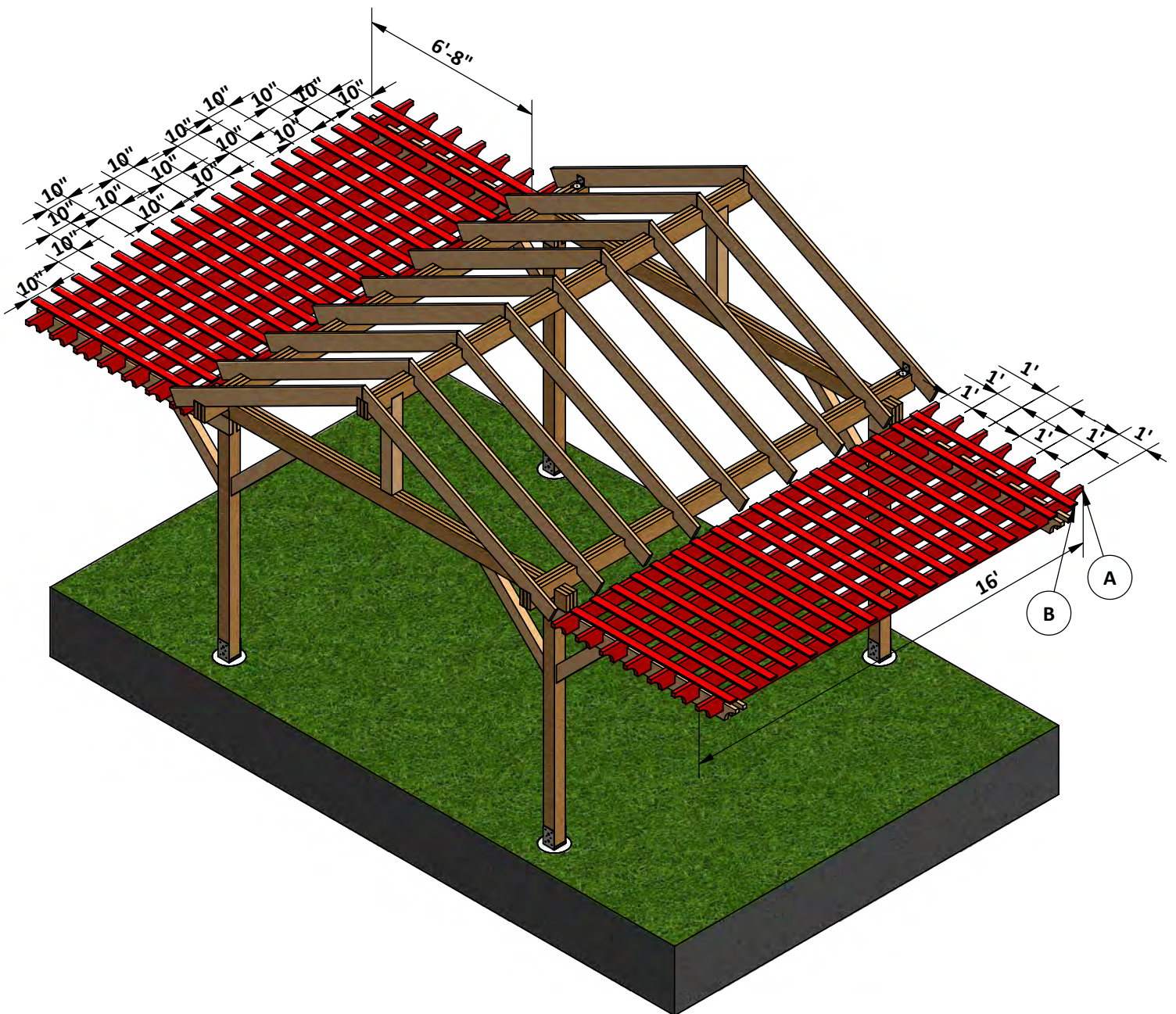
STEP 5

Side Pergolas Roof Assembly

5.1 Assemble the side pergolas roof beam using 2 x 8 Lumber and 1 x 4 lumber with halflap connection.

5.2 Secure the beam with #10 x 5" Phillips flat head wood screws and the lumber #10 x 1" Phillips flat head wood screws.

Pos	Description	Material	Dimension	Qty
A	Roof beam	Lumber (2 x 8)	16'	14
B	Roof beam	Lumber (1 x 4)	6'-8"	18
