




Assemble the Main Frame

- **1.1** Use 2x4 lumber for the main frame. You will need sixteen boards cut to 8', six boards cut to 5'-3/4'', three boards cut to 5'-3/4'' and two boards cut to 5'-2/4'' that will be the joists.
- **1.2** Use 3" screws for fasten it to the main frame.
- 1.3 Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.



Assemble the Outer Walls

- **2.1** Use 2x6 lumber for the outer walls. You will need thirty two boards cut to 8', eight boards cut to 5'-6'', eight boards cut to 5'-4 1/4" and four boards cut to 5'-3 1/2" that will be the wall joists.
- **2.2** Use 3" screws for fasten it to the main frame.
- **2.3** Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.


Assemble the Outer Bed's Walls

3.1 Use 2x2 and 2x6 lumber for the outer bed's walls. You will need twenty four boards cut to 8', eight boards cut to 5'-3'', eight boards cut to 2'-6'', eight boards cut to 2'-7 1/2" and eight boards cut to 2'-5 1/2" that will be the wall joists. You will need eleven boards cut to 2'-7 1/2" that will be the reinforcements.

3.2 Use 3" screws for fasten it to the main frame.

3.3 Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.



Assemble the Inside Bed's Walls

- **4.1** Use 2x6 lumber for the outer bed's walls. You will need thirty two boards cut to 3' and thirty two boards cut to 5'-6'' that will be the wall joists.
- **4.2** Use 3" screws for fasten it to the main frame.
- **4.3** Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.



Assemble the Front Doors


You will need two door frames.

- **5.1** Build the door frame using 2x4 lumber and secure with 5'' wood screws. For each door frame you will need three boards cut to $1'-10\ 3/4''$ that will be the horizontal girts, two boards cut to 7'-8'' that will be vertical girts and two boards cut to $3'-10\ 1/2''$ that will be the crossbraces.
- **5.2** You will need two door hinges and one handle for each door frame.
- **5.3** Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.



Mesh Wall Installation

6.1. Cover the walls with 1/4" wire mesh with the help of industrial stapler. You will need 565 sq ft.
