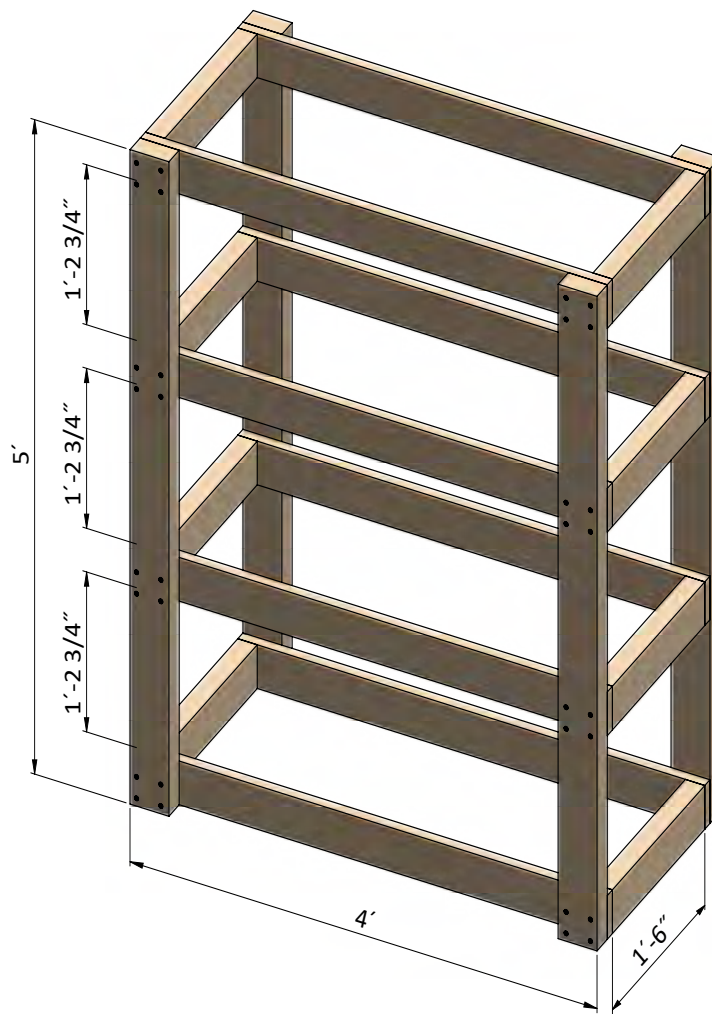
STEP 1

Assemble Main Frame

1.1. Assemble the main frame using 1" x 4" and 2" x 4" pressure-treated lumber. You will need four boards cut to 5' that will be the legs, eight boards cut to 1'-6" that will be the joists and eight boards cut to 4' that will be the joists.

1.2. Secure the beams with 3" and 5" wood screws.

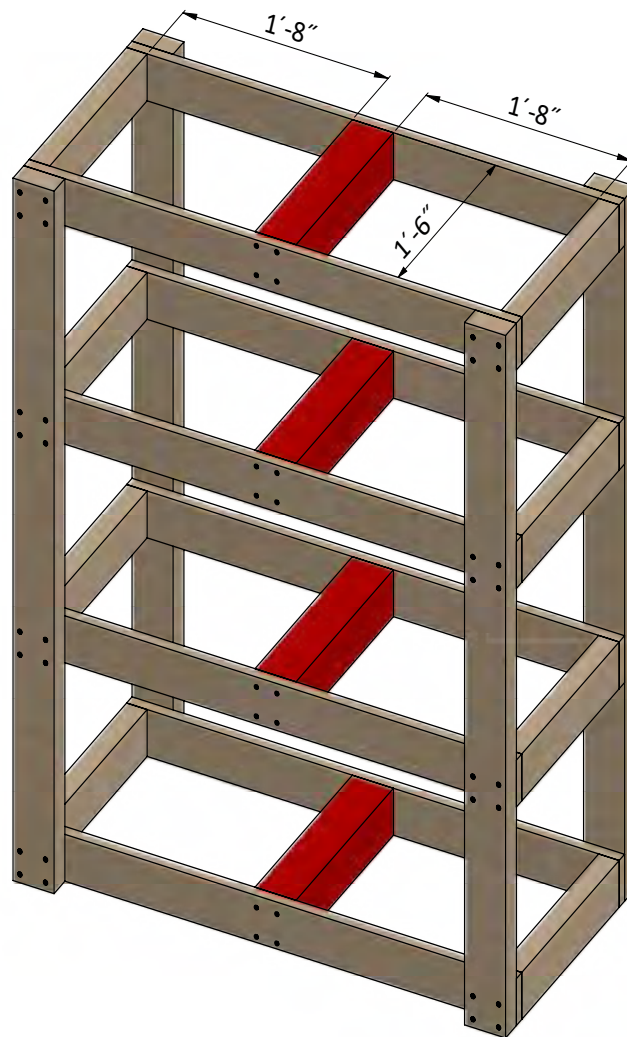
1.3. Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.



STEP 2

Assemble the Shelf Supports

- 2.1. For the shelf supports you will need 4" x 4" pressure-treated lumber. You will need four boards cut to 1'-6" that will be the shelf supports.
- 2.2. Secure the main frame with 5" wood screws.
- 2.3. Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.

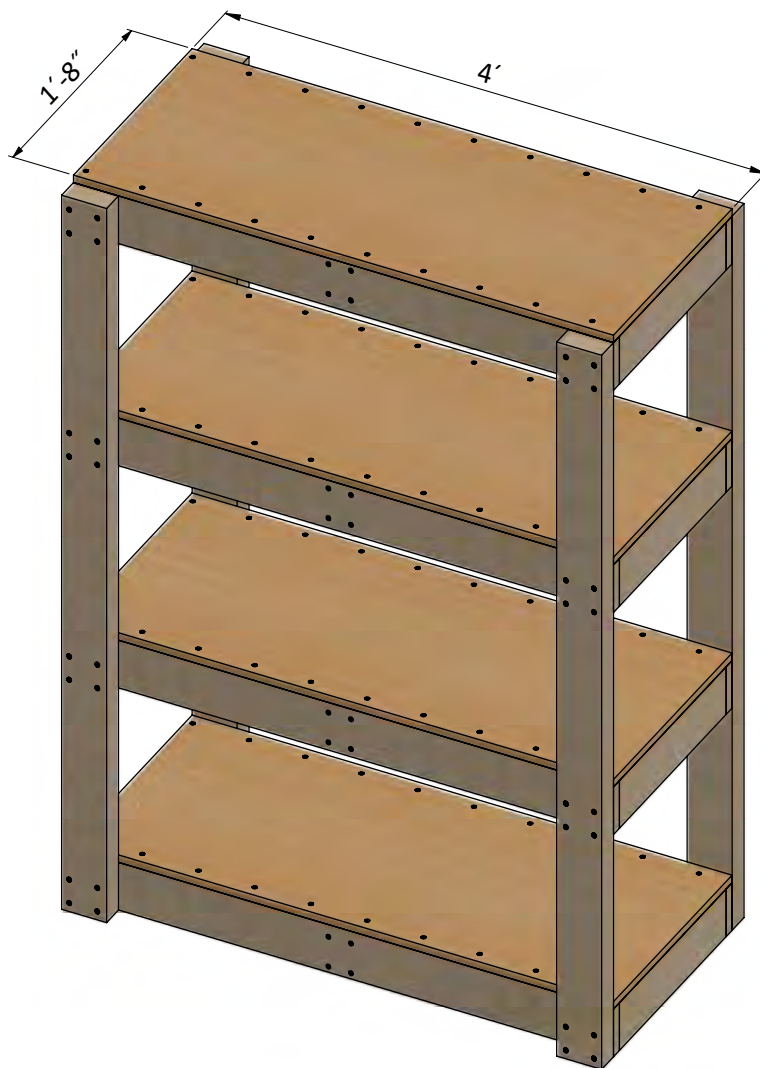


STEP 3

Install the Shelves Plywood

3.1. Cover the shelves with 5/8" plywood. You will need four sheets cut to 1'-8" x 4'.

3.2. Fasten plywood with 2" wood screws.



STEP 4

Final Touches

Now that your garage shelves is all done, you are ready to decorate it any way you want using your favorite paint, stain, or preservative.



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
