



Size & Dimensions




Assemble Main Frame

- **1.1.** Assemble the main frame using $1 \frac{1}{2}$ x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ pressure-treated lumber. You will need two boards cut to 6' and four boards cut to 2'-7" that will be the joists.
- **1.2.** Secure the beams with 4 x 5" wood screws.
- 1.3. Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.




Assemble the Walls

- **2.1.** Assemble the walls using 1 $1/2^{\circ}$ x 5 $1/2^{\circ}$, $3/4^{\circ}$ x 3 $1/2^{\circ}$ and $3/4^{\circ}$ x 4 $1/2^{\circ}$ pressure-treated lumber. You will need six boards cut to 5′-10″ and six boards cut to 2′-7″ that will be the joists, two boards cut to 1′-4 $1/2^{\circ}$ that will be studs and eight boards cut to 1′-4 $1/2^{\circ}$ that will be studs.
- **2.2.** Secure the beams with 10 x 5" and 10 x 2" wood screws.
- **2.3.** Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.




Assemble the Top Plates

- **3.1.** Assemble the top plates using 3/4 "x 2 1/2" pressure-treated lumber. You will need two boards cut to 6' and two boards cut to 3'.
- **3.2.** Connect the beams with 2" wood screws.
- **3.3.** Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.




Install Landscape Fabric

- **4.1.** Cover the bottom of garden bed with landscape fabric. You will need 18 sq.ft.
- **4.2.** Fasten landscape fabric for bottom with galvanizated nails 2".



Assemble the Side Walls

- **5.1.** Assemble the side walls using 1 $1/2^{\circ}$ x 1 $1/2^{\circ}$ and 1 $1/2^{\circ}$ x 3 $1/2^{\circ}$ pressure-treated lumber. You will need seven boards cut to 6' that will be studs, fourteen boards cut to 6' and twenty eight boards cut to 3'-1 $1/2^{\circ}$ that will be joists, one board cut to 6' that will be joist and two boards cut to 3'-1 $1/2^{\circ}$ that will be joists.
- **5.2.** Connect the beams with 2" and 5" wood screws.
- **5.3.** Using a speed square or carpenter's square, check the corners to make sure they are 90°.



Finale touches

Now that your garden bed is all done, you are ready to decorate it any way you want using your favorite paint, stain, or preservatie.
