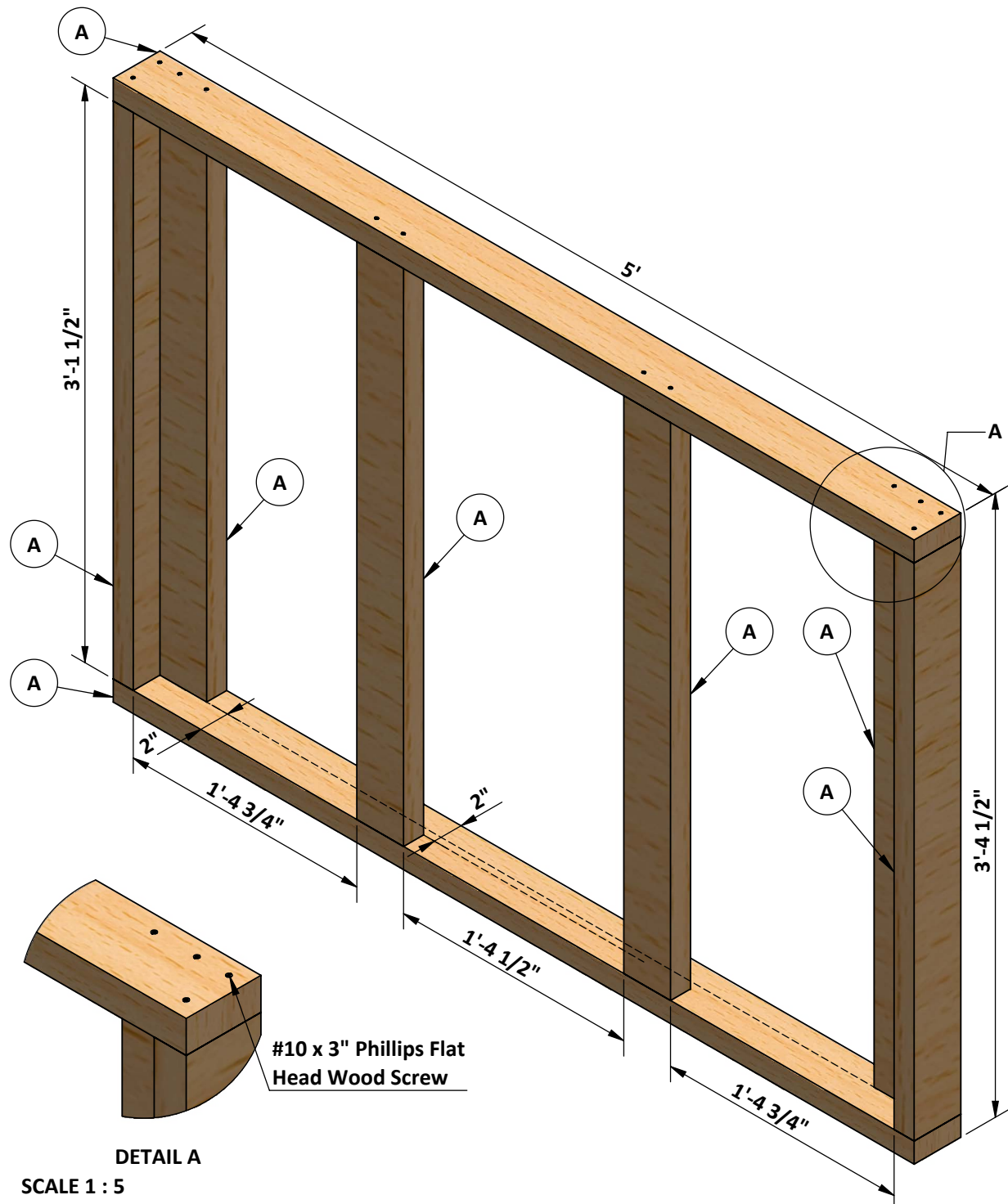
STEP 1

Outdoorbar Front Frame Assembly

1.1 Assemble the front frame using 2 x 4 lumbers.

1.2 Secure the lumbers with #10 x 3" phillips fl t head wood screws .

Pos	Descriptio	Material	Dimension	Qty
A	Top/bottom bars	Lumber (2 x 4)	5'	2
B	Side/Middle bars	Lumber (2 x 4)	3'-1 1/2"	6



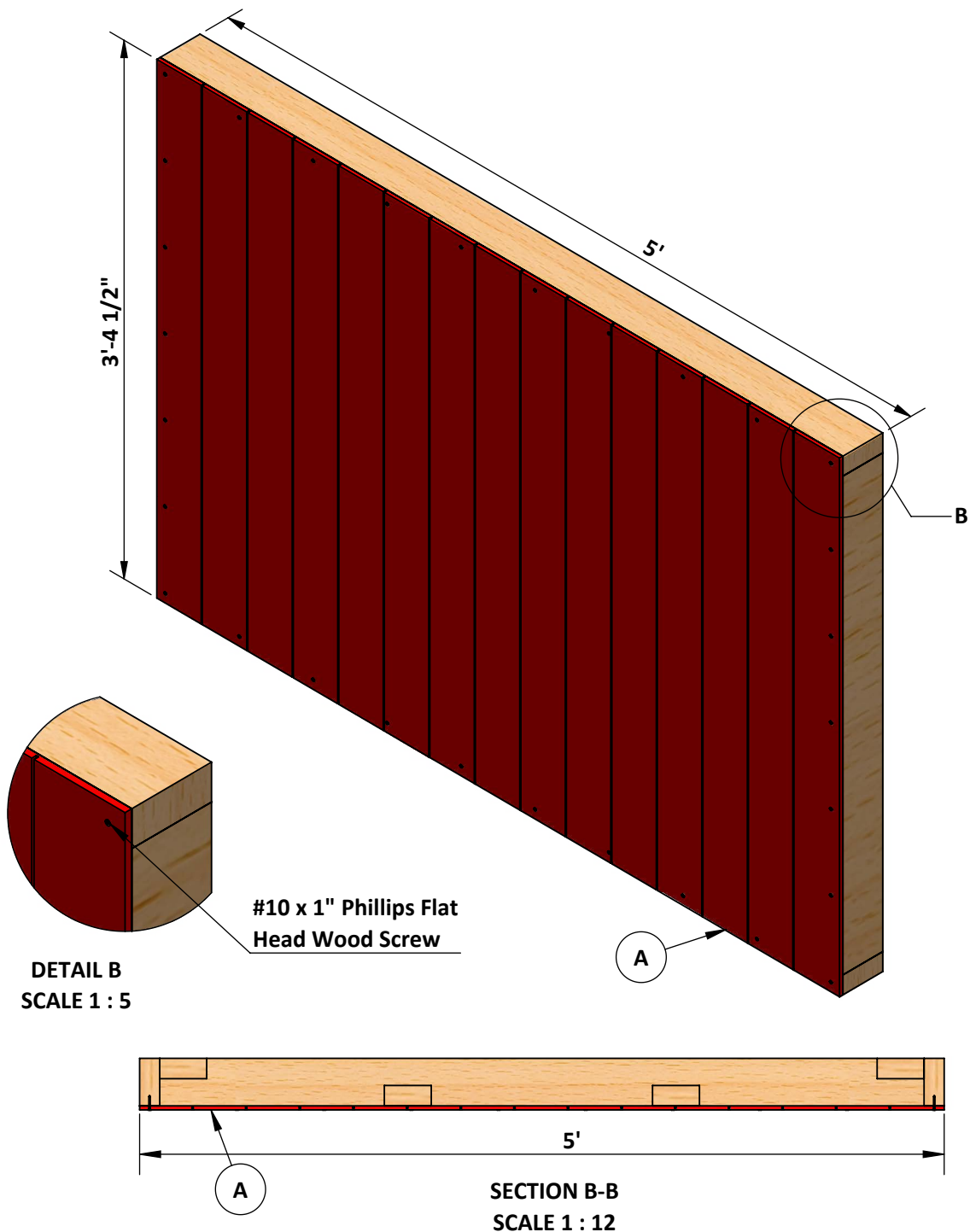
STEP 2

Bar Front sheathing Assembly

2.1 Assemble the front frame sheathing using 11/32 pl wood siding plybead.

2.2 Secure the plywood siding plybead with #10 x 1" phillips fl t head wood screws .

STEP 3

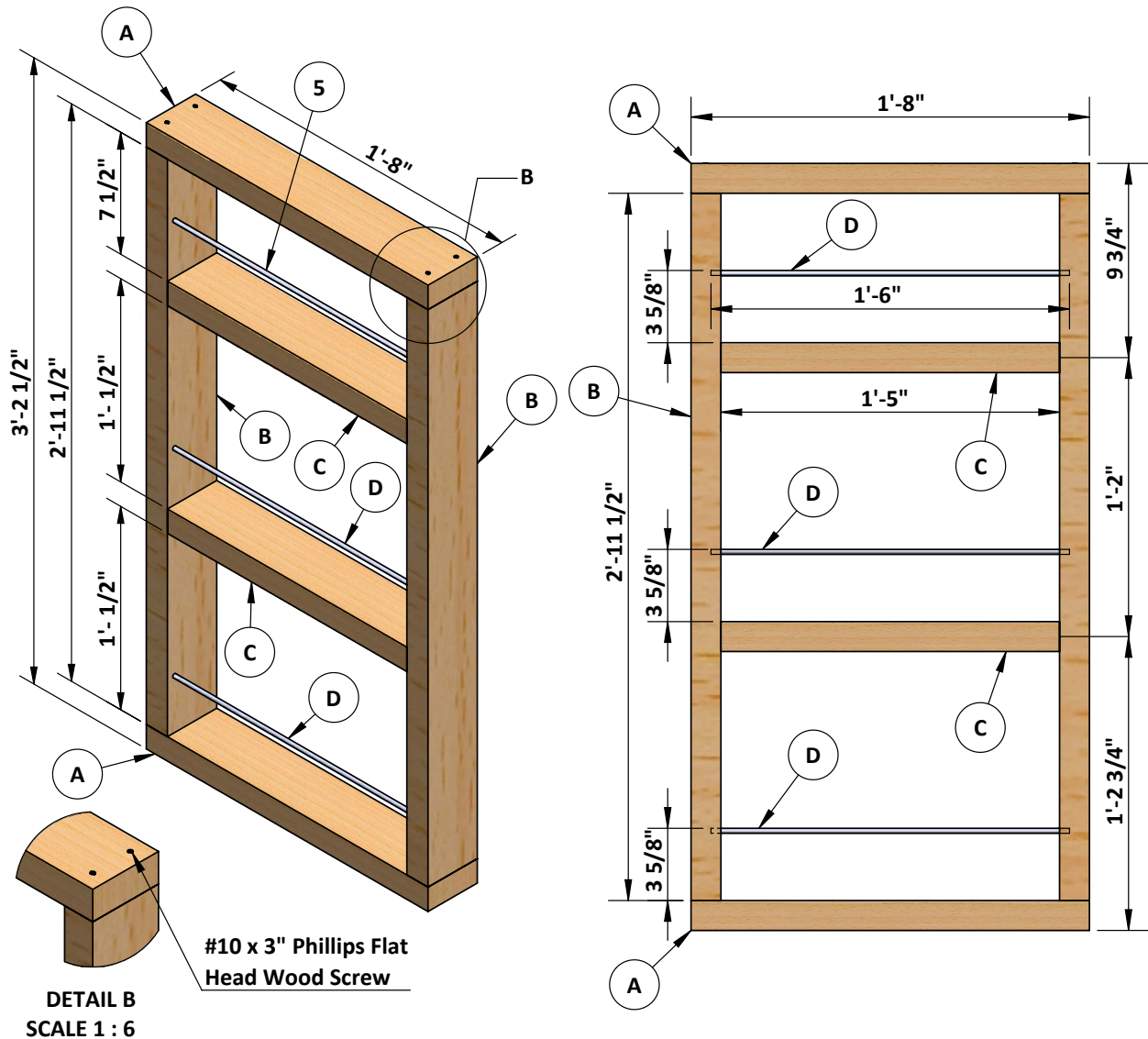
Outdoorbar Side Frame Assembly

3.1 Assemble the side frame using 2 x 4 lumbers and the frame sheathing using 11/32 plywood siding plybead.

3.2 Drill 1/4" diameter hole at the left and right lumber for inserting 1/4" rod according to the illustration below.

3.3 Secure the lumbers with #10 x 3" phillips flat head wood screws and the plywood with #10 x 1" phillips flat head wood screws.

	Side panels	Plywood Siding Plybead 11/32	1'-8" x 3'-2 1/2"	2



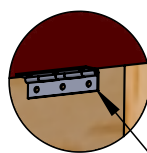
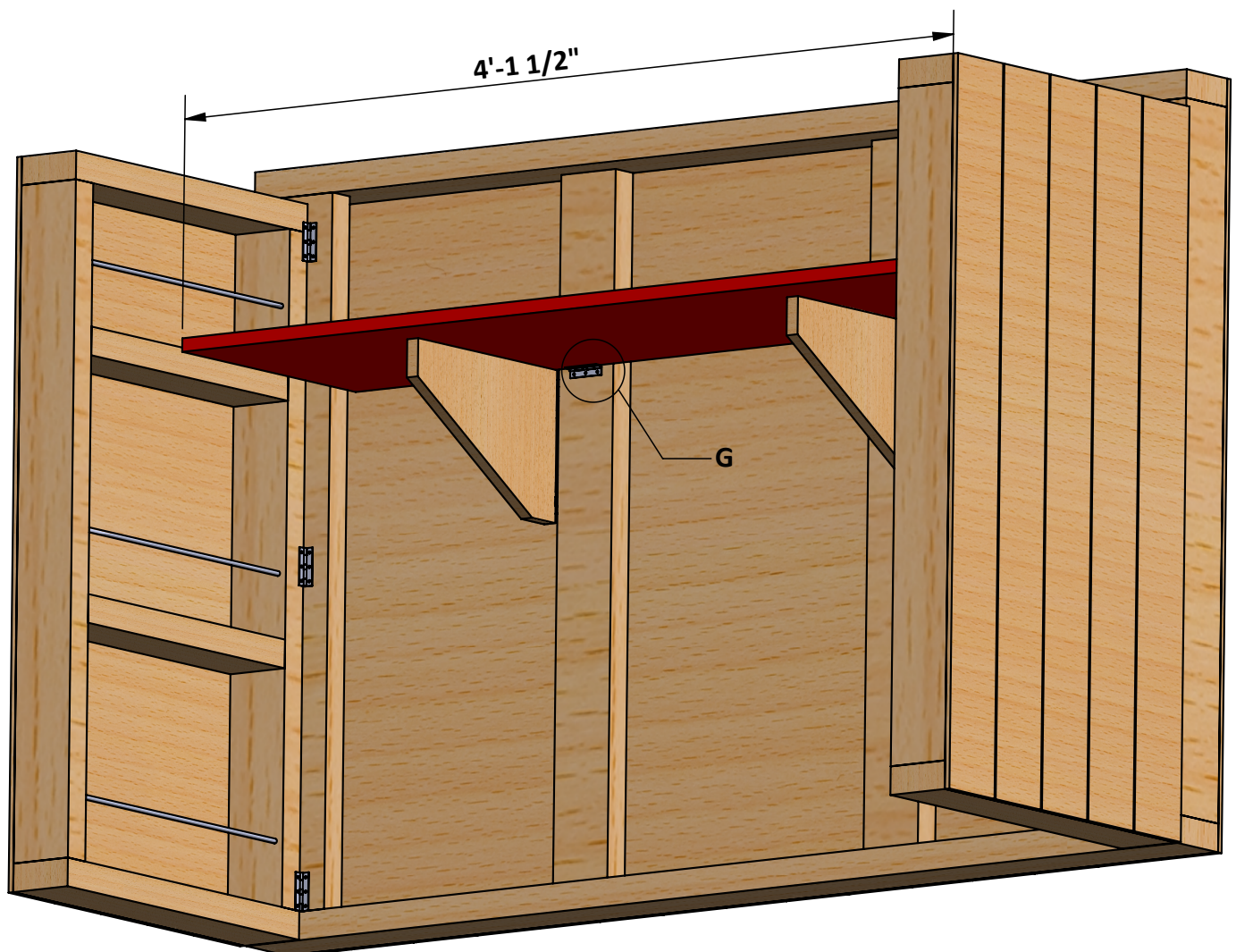
STEP 4

Outdoorbar Upper Shelf Assembly

4.1 Assemble the upper shelf using 3/4 plywood according to the illustration below.

4.2 Secure the plywood with 2" hinges and #10 x 1" phillips flat head wood screws.

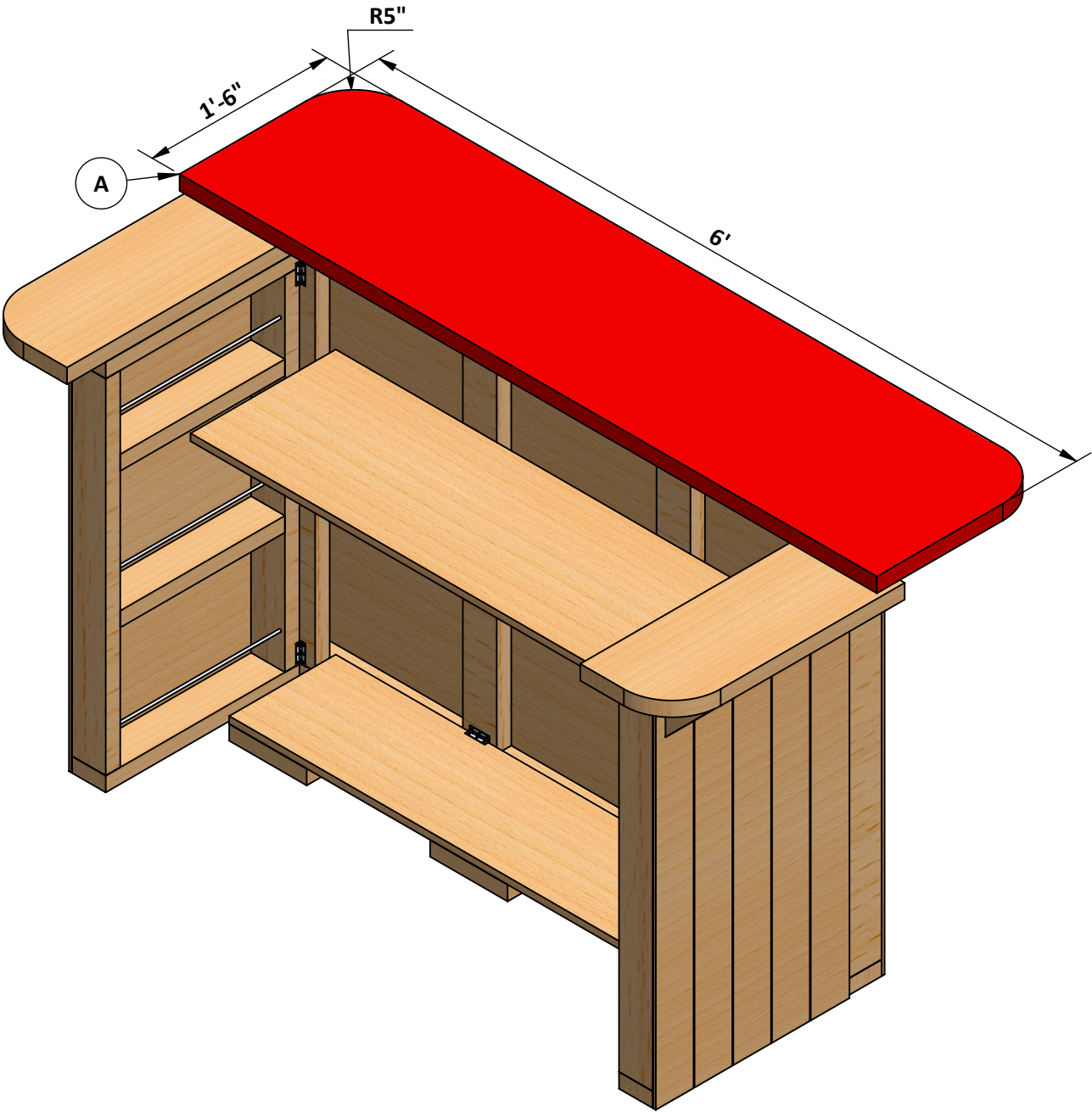
STEP 6

Outdoorbar Front Top Assembly

6.1 Assemble the front top using 1 1/2" butcher block.

6.2 Secure the butcher block with the front frame with 10" folding shelf brackets and #10 x 1" phillips flat head wood screws.
